

The third stage of the abolition of restrictions related to COVID-19 – 18th May 2020

I. Economic activity

- **Gastronomy**

It will be possible to eat in a restaurant, café, bar, as well as in a shopping centre (in a separate gastronomic space).

Important! The guest will be able to have a meal both in the hall, inside and in the restaurant garden.

Rules:

- limit of persons in the venue (there must be at least 4 m² per person),
- placing information about the maximum number of people at the entrance to the venue,
- designation of safe outdoor areas for people waiting to enter. Bringing guests to a particular free table,
- keeping 2 m distance between tables.

Important! The counters may be 1 m apart, provided that the tables are additionally separated by partitions at least 1 m above the tabletop,

- keeping a distance of 1.5 m from people sitting at separate tables,
- wearing masks and gloves by cooks and staff.

Important! Restaurant guests can take off their masks if they are already sitting at the tables,

- hand disinfection by customers will be obligatory at the entrance to the venue. Inside the venue, there will be dispensers with hand sanitizer for guests in the area of the dining room (at the order and checkout points) and at the exit from toilets,
- there will be no possibility to use self-service spaces (salad bars, buffets and drink dispensers),
- it is required to disinfect the table after serving guests of the restaurant, and after completed disinfection, the table should be marked “disinfected”.

- **Hair and beauty salons**

Rules:

- the obligation for customers and staff to wear masks, goggles or visors (at the hairdresser and in the beauty salon - if the treatment allows it),
- using disposable towels when it is possible,
- accepting customers by appointment only by phone or online. **Attention!** The customer cannot wait for the service in the waiting room,
- there may be as many clients in a beauty salon as there are positions to serve them. If we have 3 manicure positions and another 3 pedicure positions, there can be a maximum of 6 clients at the same time. Let's make sure that customers don't come to the salon with accompanying persons,
- in a hair salon, the client should be wearing a mask. She or he can only take it off for the duration of the procedure if it concerns a covered face area,
- obligatory hand disinfection after the customer enters the salon,

- the hairdresser should wear gloves (if the type of service allows it), cover the mouth and nose, e. g. through masks. Workers may additionally use protective goggles or visors for increased safety.

II. Social life

- **Religious ceremonies (from 17 May)**

During a mass or other ritual, there must be 10 m² per 1 participant. So far, there have been 15 m² per 1 person.

III. International transport

- air traffic: domestic and international passenger flights suspended until 23 May with the possibility of extension.
- International rail transport operations: international train journeys suspended until further notice.
