INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OFFICE REPORT 2017/2018

International Relations Office of AIK coordinates international exchange within the European Union Erasmus+ Programme in years 2014-2020: mobility project for higher education students and staff; Key Action 1: Learning Mobility for Individuals.

Within this action there is a possibility of student and staff mobility in programme countries – Action KA103 (mainly within the European Union's countries) and since 2017 AIK has been implemented academic exchange with partnership Universities from partner countries – Action KA107 (beyond the EU).

In the frame of Erasmus programme, students might go abroad for study or internship and staff members might go for conducting lectures or for training. The student mobility for study and staff mobility for teaching are possible if there is a signed a bilateral agreement within Erasmus+ Programme between universities.

At this moment, AIK has signed **65 bilateral** agreements within Erasmus+ Programme:

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE – STATISTICS

International exchange within the Erasmus+ Programme has become still more popular not only among students but also staff members. The University organizes **more than 100** activities per year including arrivals and departures.

In 2017/2018 **56 outgoing mobilities** had been implemented:

student mobility for study	17

MOBILITY WITH PARTNER COUNTRIES – KA107 Action

Since 2017 Jesuit University Ignatianum is realizing academic exchange within Erasmus+ Programme – Action KA107- mobility with partner countries (from outside the European Union).

Currently, the university implements 2 projects:

KA107-2017 Project which includes students' arrivals from Zhytomyr Ivan Franko State University in Ukraine in order to study at AIK and bilateral mobility of staff members to teach.

The exchange within the project is possible in years 2017/2018 and 2018/2019.

Granting endowment allowed realizing 7 mobilities in 2017/2018:

- 3 students' mobilities (incoming)
- 2 staff mobilities for teaching (incoming)
- 2 staff mobilities for teaching (outgoing)

KA107-2018 Project involves academic exchange of students and staff with 4 partner universities giving the possibility to carry out 25 mobilities:

- 1. Zhytomyr Ivan Franko State University (10 mobilities)
- 2. Saint-Joseph University in Beirut (9 mobilities)
- 3. Loyola University Chicago (5 mobilities)
- 4. Catholic University of Uruguay (1 mobility)

The exchange within the project is possible in years 2018/2019 and 2019/2020.

INTERINSTITUTIONAL CONTRACTS

International Relations Office supports and monitors preparation of interinstitutional agreements on scientific collaboration.

For the present, AIK has signed 34 interinstitutional contracts. Only in year 2017/2018 AIK has established cooperation with **13** new foreign universities.
