Erasmus+ staff mobility from Programme Countries (KA103)

- Duration of the mobility is 2-5 days.
- Within mobility for teaching (STA), staff member of the partner university is obliged to conduct at least 8 hours of classes for students of Jesuit University Ignatianum in Krakow or 4 hours of classes combined with a training.
- In case of training mobility (STT), the training programme must be scheduled for each day of the mobility.
- While planning your mobility, please check our <u>academic calendar</u>.
- Minimum level of foreign language proficiency in which lectures/training will be conducted is B2 (English) or B1 (Polish) according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- Academic teachers interested in a teaching visit at Jesuit University Ignatianum in Krakow should contact the IRO (<u>erasmus@ignatianum.edu.pl</u>) which will then pass forward the query to the related Faculty Coordinator of the university in order to check possibility for hosting.

The provisionally completed Staff Mobility for Teaching Mobility Agreement (STA) with proposition of lectures is also required to be sent.

The provisionally completed Staff Mobility for Training Mobility Agreement (STT) with proposition of work plan for each day of mobility is also required to be sent.
