

New safety rules in Poland

From Saturday, 24 October 2020 the whole country is in red zone.

It means that:

- it is obliged to cover mouth and nose in all public places
- it is forbidden to organize any gatherings, meetings or events for more than 5 people
- all restaurants are closed, only take-away meals can be ordered
- there must be limited number of people in public transport - 50% of seats may be occupied or 30% of the total capacity of the vehicle
- swimming pools, aquaparks and gyms are closed
- during religious ceremonies no more than 1 person per 7m² may participate, keeping distance of 1.5 meter with others
- from Monday to Friday between 10:00 and 12:00, there are shopping hours only for people aged over 60 years
- there is limit of number of people in retail outlets to 5 people per 1 cash register (if shop is up to 100 m²) or 1 person per 15m²
- remote teaching is obligatory in universities and secondary schools, and from Monday 26th Oct. also in elementary schools (from 4th grade)
- there is ban on organizing special events (i.e. weddings or other celebrations);
