

**March 13th 2020 - Preventative measures set up at Jesuit University Ignatianum in Krakow (AIK), Poland against the spread of the coronavirus causing COVID-19 disease**

1. all academic activities and public events organized by AIK were cancelled, until further notice,
2. all visits of foreign guests to AIK were suspended, until further notice,
3. **till 8th of April 2020**, all face-to-face classes were cancelled. The students (Polish and foreigners) have chance to follow the classes on the basis of the remote learning activities. All students have received the teachers' instructions about it,
4. the university library will be closed till **14th of April 2020**,
5. the validity of Polish Student ID card has been automatically extended until **31st of May 2020**,
6. there is a strict ban for the students entering university premises in order to avoid face-to-face contacts. All offices might be reach only via email or phone (<https://ignatianum.edu.pl/kontakt>; <https://ignatianum.edu.pl/kontakt25>; <https://www.ignatianum.edu.pl/kontakt30>),
7. we have been supporting all the foreign exchange students to finish their semester successfully. If the exchange students wished to cancel or interrupt their mobility, they must contact the International Office via email - [incoming@ignatianum.edu.pl](mailto:incoming@ignatianum.edu.pl), as well as their home university. Further actions will be taken accordingly
